55 Credits are required for graduation - 37 required credits, 18 elective credits

#### Grade 9 Core Requirements:

English (2) English 9A and English 9B; or Pre-AP English 9A and 9B

Social Studies (1) American Citizenship

Science (3) Principles of Chemistry, Principles of Engineering, and

Principles of Physics

Mathematics (2) 2 Math Courses (see Mathematics section)

#### Grade 10 Core Requirements:

English (2) English 10A and English 10B; or Pre-AP English 10A and 10B

Social Studies (2) US History A and US History B; or

Advanced Placement US History (meets 2 credit social requirement)

Science (2) Cellular Biology and Biological Systems

Mathematics (2) 2 Math Courses (see Mathematics section)

#### Grade 11 Core Requirements:

English (2) Composition 11; and American Literature 11 or Themes in Literature 11 (choose one); or

Advanced Placement Language and Composition (meets 2 credit English requirement)

Social Studies (2) World History A and B; or

Advanced Placement World History (meets 2 credit social requirement)

Mathematics (2) 2 Math Courses (see Mathematics section)

#### Grade 12 Core Requirements:

English (2) Composition 12 or College Freshman Composition SMSU (choose one); and

Themes in Literature 12 or World Literature (choose one); or

Advanced Placement Literature and Composition (meets 2 credit English

requirement)

Social Studies (2) Economics and Government 12; or

Advanced Placement US Government (meets 2 credit social requirement)

Senior Seminar (1) Intended to better prepare students for their postsecondary experiences

#### General Core Requirements:

Physical Ed (2) Foundations of Fitness (suggested in grade 9 or 10); and

One additional Physical Education class of choice

Health (1) Health (suggested in grade 9 or 10)

Speech (1) Speech (suggested in grade 10, 11, or 12)

Mathematics (1) See Mathematics section for required sequence

Science (2) Chemistry A and B or Physics A and B Social Studies (1) Human Geography (open to grades 10-12)

Fine Arts (2) Choose 2 classes in the area of art or music. Or, see below

These classes may also be used to meet the Fine Arts requirement: Drama, Creative Writing, Video Production, Interior Design, Metals Technology (2 credits), Cabinetry and Furniture Making (2 credits)

### Be sure you have what you need for your future!

## 4-year schools use these preparation requirements as a general guide for admission

•English: 4 years (8 credits)

•Science: 2 years + 1 year of lab experience

Social Studies: 2-4 years (4-8 credits )

•Mathematics: 3 years (U of M system requires 4 years, for example)

•Foreign Language: 2-4 years must be in a single language

#### Postsecondary Credit Opportunities through Waconia High School

This document outlines six categories whereby students may earn college credits without leaving Waconia High School. Please see the Waconia High School Registration Handbook for course descriptions. Course offerings are dependent upon student registration.

#### Advanced Placement Courses

Advanced placement courses offer students access to rigorous college-level coursework and the opportunity to explore a subject of interest in greater depth. These introductory college courses often require more time and work, but help students develop disciplined study habits that can contribute to success in college. Satisfactory AP exam scores allow students to earn college credit and bypass introductory-level courses in college to pursue more advanced studies.
