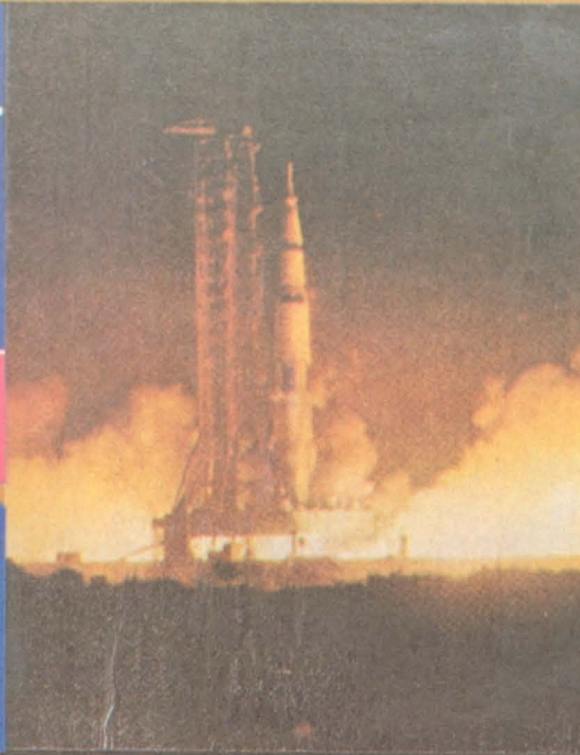
"W" Club

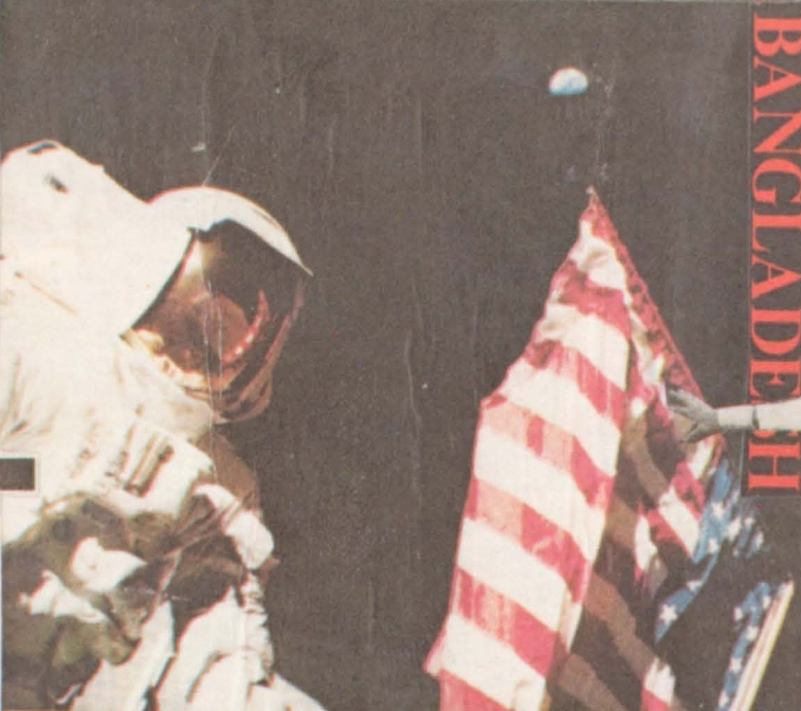

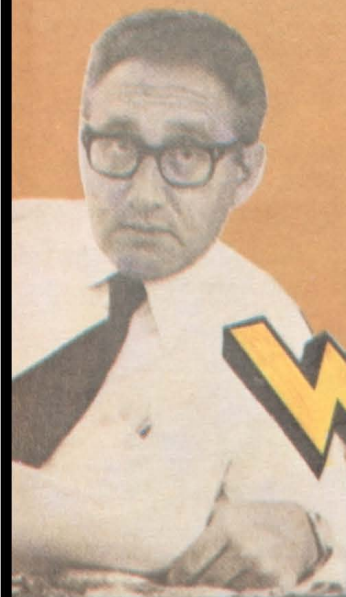

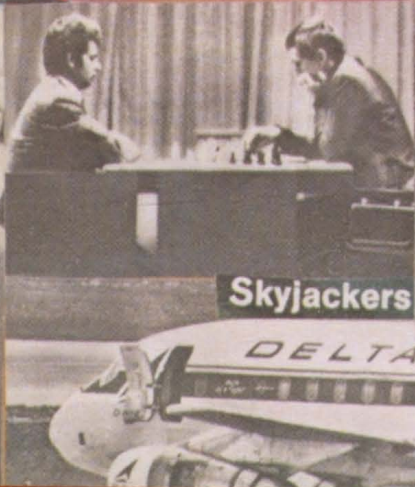
