Drop Off and Pick up

Drop off and pick up will happen in the back of the building.

Express check in will be from 7:00 - 8:15

Door #12will be open from 6:00-8:30 and 4:00-6:15 for drop off and pick up. There will be a person staffing this door for you to drop off and pick up. If you drop off or pick up outside of those hours you will need to call 763-458-5217 to notify the staff you are here. This number will also be posted on door #12

Kids' Company is open from 6:00am - 6:15pm Late pick up policy-\$1 per minute per child

Building Security

All door will be remained locked except for door #12 during the posted times

Only staff and children are allowed in the buildings

Typical Schedule

- 6:00-830 drop off and table games/gym and playground
- 8:30-8:40 Groups gather for attendance
- 8:45-9:45 Snack and enrichment activity
- 9:45-12:00 Station rotation
- 12:00-1:00 Lunch
- 1:00-1:30 break
- 1:30-4:00 Station rotation
- 4:00-6:15 Group spaces activity

Food Options

- Cafe #110 will be offering morning and afternoon snack along with lunch.
- Families had the option of choosing prepaid lunch or pay as you go
- Your account will be billed \$4.50 per lunch for the option of pay as you go
- Prepay is no longer an option
- Families are still welcome to provide their own snacks and lunch
- If you bring your lunch from home you will also need to bring your snack
- A lunch menu will be posted Friday
- Lunch will be eaten in the lunchroom

CAN I SIGN MY CHILD UP FOR EXTRA CLASSES

We have collaborated with Koch bus company to transport your student to Community Education classes in Waconia at no charge.

Forms MUST be turned in two week prior to be included in the Koch bus company transportation option. Due to logistics of this opportunity we are unable to make any exceptions to the two week notification.

We will be working with CE and camp staff to make sure students Pre-K-1st are helped from the bus to their activity location and back to the bus once activity is done. We may also assign older students that are attending camps in the building to help when needed.

Students that are 2nd and older will be expected to be able to find their activity location off the bus and come back to the bus when activity is over.

Students will all have lanyards with camp information and bus drivers along with camp staff will have class list

Field Trips

- A schedule of field trips were shared with families
- ☐ Families had the option of choosing prepaid or paying two weeks prior to trip
- If you have prepaid and need to cancel. Your account will be credited as longs as a two week notice was given.
- Do to limited staff we are unable to provide alternative care for students not attending their field trip. You will not have to take a comp day if not attending the field trip
- Some field trips may conflict with summer school
- At open house the group leads will have what each student is signed up for
- If you need to change this the form will be available on the website on Friday
