The Importance of Eye Exams

Eye exams are an important part of your
child's wellness and development.

Comprehensive eye exams are an important part of everyone's health care. While most people think of an eye exam as testing your eyes to see if you have 20/20 vision, that is actually just a small portion of what eye doctors look at during eye exams. Examining the overall health of the eye includes evaluating the eye surface (sclera & conjunctiva), measuring the responsiveness of patients' pupils and looking at the interior of the eye to ensure there are no signs of ocular health issues or even overall health issues such as diabetes or brain tumors. Optometrists and Ophthalmologists also look at the health of the ocular nerve and the cells in that region of the eye. In addition eye doctors evaluate the function and motility of eye muscles. This is particularly important in infants and toddlers. If a child suffers from strabismus

(misaligned eyes) it can often be treated without surgery if addressed early enough. This is also the case for children with amblyopia (lazy eye). Working closely with skilled opticians, eye doctors can often correct this issue through corrective lenses and/or patching children's eyes. If routine vision care isn't part of your health care routine, consider scheduling an appointment for you and your family with one of our skilled optometrists.
