ISD ONE10 PROTOCOLS

There are many complexities and requirements from the state that will need to be followed as we make decisions on how ISD 110 will deliver the best education possible in the safest environment in this new model. We understand that decisions made in all of our planning impact every student and every family in multiple ways. The best interests of all students, staff and families are at the center of our planning.

HEALTH AND HYGIENE

- · All MDH and CDC guidelines will be followed
- · Mandatory masks for students and adults
- Maintain social distancing reinforced with signage
- Hand sanitizing stations and routine hand washing in classrooms where sinks are available
- Routine cleaning during the school day of all high traffic and common areas, and nightly deep cleaning of all facilities
- Enhancement to air handling equipment to increase fresh air and improve filtration
- Protocols for what happens when someone tests positive for the virus while following student and staff personal information confidentiality laws

FACILITIES AND ROUTINES

- No large group assemblies
- No fountain use
- Students bring water bottles

ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL

- Parents stay in vehicle
- Follow established school protocols



RECESS

- Students wash hands before and after recess
- K-5 students will have access to recess daily within their pods
- Middle School students will have a 10 minute recess at the end of their lunch period



SELF-SCREEN & STAY HOME WITH THESE SYMPTOMS

- New onset cough or shortness of breath
- · Fever 100.0°F or higher
- Chills
- Muscle pain
- · Sore throat
- Loss of sense of smell or taste
- · Gastrointestinal symptoms of diarrhea, vomiting or nausea

ISD 110 will follow MDH exclusionary guidelines

ELECTIVE COURSES

- Any shared equipment will be sanitized between uses
- Specials except physical education will take place in the classroom



BUS TRANSPORTATION

- All students must wear a mask while on the bus
- Drivers will be masked when passengers are on board
- 1 student per seat unless students live together
- Hand sanitizer will be available on request for students to use
- Drivers will have extra masks available for students who forget
- Buses will be disinfected between routes and deep cleaned once daily
- Drivers will have temperatures checked before work and areas to congregate will be closed

CAFETERIA PROCEDURES


- Frequent handwashing will be required throughout the day especially before eating snacks or meals
- All K-12 meals will be packaged in recyclable "Grab in Go" containers with a cup of fresh milk
- All meal "extras" will be packaged in individual packaging
- · Strategic meal check-out options will be in place to protect all students

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL LEARNING POD INSTRUCTIONAL MODEL

LEARNING PODS

- This model meets the requirements of both In-Person and Hybrid Learning with safety precautions built throughout.
- The Learning Pod Instructional Model utilizes all areas within the building allowing all K-5 families the option for their child(ren) to attend school daily.
- K 5 will have every day instruction in small groups we call learning pods (students will stay within their learning pods during the school day using social distancing and safety protocols).



 Instruction, support, and supervision throughout the school day for each learning pod will be delivered by two licensed elementary teachers and one educational assistant.



TRANSPORTATION

• With limited bus capacity due to social distancing requirements, we will NEED to partner with families to drive their children, or carpool, to school.



TIMING

• The K-5 school day will be adjusted to a start time of 8:30am with dismissal at 2:30pm.





Parents with students in all grades will have the option to opt out of in-person instruction for their child(ren) and ISD 110 will provide a distance learning education for those students.

This Distance Learning model will be even more enhanced and interactive when compared to the distance learning that finished out the 2019-2020 school year.

• Students on an "AB" Rotation
"A" students will be in person on Monday and Thursday
and "B" students will be in person on Tuesday and Friday.























 Wednesday will be a day for pre-identified students to receive required additional services, time for staff development, and planning.

FAMILIES WITH MULTIPLE STUDENTS

• For families with multiple students on the "AB" rotation, attention will be given to keep siblings on the same rotation.
