WHAT IF A STUDENT FEELS SICK?



STEP BY STEP SCENARIO

Notify school building front office

to report absence and symptoms.

Student feels sick at home.

STOP STAY HOME Student feels sick at school.

Teacher contacts school nurse.

Nurse evaluates/assesses student.

Student has symptoms consistent with other medical diagnoses, such as: allergies; asthma; diabetes; etc.

Nurse reviews symptoms to determine if connected to a pre-existing health condition.

Student will receive nursing interventions and/or treatments.

Student has symptoms consistent with COVID-19.

Parent will be contacted to pick up child.

Nurse will review MDH exclusionary guidelines with parents and encourage parents to contact medical provider.

In accordance with MDH exclusionary guidelines, the student's household members, including siblings in the district, will need to go home as well.

Student's health condition improves, student feels better, and/or it has been determined that symptoms are connected to a pre-existing health condition. Student returns to class.

No improvement of symptoms or student's health condition.

Parents will be contacted to pick up student.

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
