Description of activity: NHS is an honorary organization that recognizes student academic achievement, extra-curricular involvement, and community service.

Length of season: All year, students are accepted in May and are members through the following school year.

Meeting/Practice times: 1 meeting/month, posting of information is done via Schoology group

Meeting/Practice sites: B107

Competitions/Performances: Induction ceremony in May of each year.

Eligibility requirements: All candidates must have the following qualities: a cumulative grade point average of 3.55 (on a 4.0 scale) or higher, show evidence of satisfactory participation in multiple athletic and academic activities at WHS, perform a minimum of 40 and up to 80 additional hours of community service, and one's character must be held in high esteem. Application process, members are selected by a committee.

Average number of members: 70-100 members each year, 11th & 12th graders

Costs and/or needed equipment: \$5 Yearly Dues (used for materials needed for service projects). Option to purchase a NHS t-shirt is provided each year.

Fundraising/Service Activities: 5-7 group volunteer activities each year. This year they include: Relay for Life, Adopt-a-Highway Clean-up, Fleece Blankets for Blankets for a Brighter Day, Feed My Starving Children, and the serving at the Jazz Dinner.

Student Leadership: Four senior officers are selected each year: President, Vice President, Secretary, and Historian
