Makes you get the sillies!!!

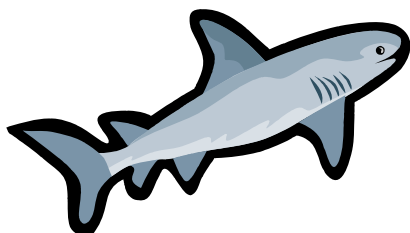
BABY SHARK

brother, sister, baby

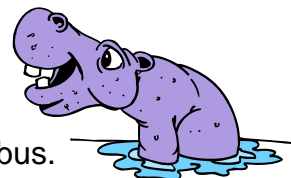
A HIPPOPOTAMUS

quiet as could be.....SNAP!

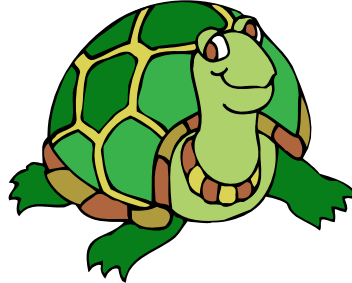
Repeat with 4, 3, 2, 1
