- AED Additions to the District: 3 new AEDs will be purchased this month and placed in the new addition to the HS (2) and 1 in the WLC West entrance. The Waconia Lions Club donated \$1,500 towards the purchase of the New AED equipment for the Schools.
- 6. New updated AED location maps will be produced and given to Local Law Enforcement.

- Safe Schools Online Training Modules can help reduce class room training times for CPR Certification. Please inform staff that need to renew Certification to go into Safe Schools and complete the training before they go to the class for Recertification.
- 8. WLC Lockdown Preparedness Issues were discussed. Parts are on order.
- 9. The possible future use and availability of Narcan was discussed.
- 10. Timely Snow and Ice Cleaning of Sidewalks, Crosswalks, and Emergency exits were discussed. Can we get more attention to clearing these areas? Especially the Middle School crossing to the Ice Arena.
- 11. Still waiting to get a report re: the speed issue on HWY 5, Committee Members were going to talk to the City about possibly adding signage and/or Flashing lights to the stretch of HWY 5 that runs between Oak St. stop lights and the Roundabout at Orchard/ CR10.
- 12. Also brought up were the Roundabouts on the west end of town need better salting and sanding during inclement weather. They are City Streets now, not School District.
- 13. WHS Construction Punch List Items were brought up. (Chemical shelving, Science lab Ventilation, Lab stools) Dave Grandy will look into resolutions for these items.
