## Drivers Education: Classroom Instruction

The date of their 16th birthday, along with the date of registration, will determine their priority on the waiting list. We encourage students to register early. Please do not schedule your driver's test before you start your 6 hours of Behind the Wheel. If you are participating in an after school activity, please be aware that this limits your scheduling availability with the instructors.

At this time, Community Education is extremely behind in our Behind the Wheel lessons. Please note that if you sign up with us. There will be no guarantee that we will get your 6 hours of driving done before your 16th birthday. If you choose to sign up with us and you decide to cancel there will be a fee of \$25 that will be non-refundable.

The "Blue Card" allows the student to take the Minnesota State Permit test. There is no course credit given to students who take this class during the summer thru Community Education. 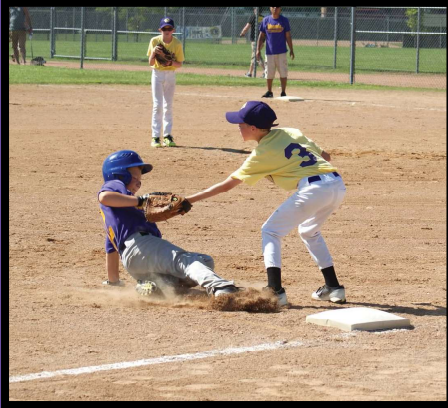
