Waconia Public Schools, also known as Independent School District 110, empowers students to explore their passions and create their success by providing opportunities for academic, social, and emotional growth. Located about 35 miles west of Minneapolis, we serve the cities of Waconia, Victoria, New Germany, Minnetrista, and St. Bonifacius. CURRICULUM & GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

SCHEDULE

- Students at Waconia High School participate in a 5-period trimester schedule.
- Each class period meets for 70 minutes.
- Each class can be considered 1 semester credit, as our yearlong classes are condensed into 2 trimesters.

CREDIT REQUIREMENTS

- Students have an opportunity to earn 15 credits per year and are required to earn 55 credits to graduate.
- 37 credits are required, 18 are electives
- 8 credits required in English
- 8 credits required in Social Studies
- 7 credits required in Mathematics
- 7 credits required in Science
- 2 credits required in Physical Education
- 1 credit required in Health
- 1 credit required in Speech
- 2 credits required in Fine Arts
- 1 credit required in Senior Seminar
